

Safari Camp Check List

The following is a checklist of items we would like you to bring to Safari Overnight Adventure Camp. We hope this list helps you out.

- One duffel bag of clothing including shorts, t-shirts, swimsuits, tennis shoes, hiking boots or Tevas, (flip-flops are not good). We do a lot of walking. Lots of underwear!
- One Pair of blue jeans for horseback riding
- Two Beach Towels
- Toiletries (tooth brush, shampoo, soap etc.)
- Sunscreen.
(We use it a lot so practice putting it on prior to camp)
- Laundry Bag for dirty clothes
- A sack lunch and drink for the ride up to Mo-Ranch
- Medication (If Applicable)
(If taking, all medications must be submitted to Camp Director and a Medical Dosage Form must be filled out. All medications must be in original container)
- Copy of your child's Immunization Record
(If we do not already have it)
- Signed waivers for Horseback Riding and Ropes Course
- One Water Bottle (Sturdy, Reusable, Large Opening)
- A costume for the costume party
- A Backpack to carry your "stuff" in
- Camp Journal and Pen (Session III Requirement Only)

*All bedding and bathroom towels are provided at camp.

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

Camera, journal, CD Player (only during free time), flashlight, snacks (must be in sealed containers), snorkel and mask, book, money for gift shop, post card, and a cap or hat.

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING:

Cell Phones, Electronic devices, Game Boys, matches, knives, or fireworks
